Overall, for the year 2022, Athens International Airport's number of flights amounted to 213 thousand, increased by 34.2% vs 2021 and below the 2019 levels by 5.4%. Analytically, both domestic and international flights surpassed the 2021 levels by 30.9% and 37.1%, respectively. Domestic operations also exceeded the 2019 levels by 2.9%, while international services were below the 2019 levels by 11.4%.

Notes

As of January 2022, comparison to the respective month of 2021 and 2019 (passengers' and flights' figures) is presented. It is reminded that the pandemic's impact was initially recorded mid-March 2020 onwards.

December 2022 traffic statistics are provisional and subject to change; traffic data for the previous month are finalised following the 20th of each month
